As believers, we are called to live by faith, not by our feelings (2 Cor. 5:7). Our faith should be grounded in God and the infallible Word of God. It must guide our thoughts, words, and actions rather than our ever-changing emotions. However, we often find ourselves in situations where our faith and feelings conflict. We might say things like, "Although I repented of my sin, I still feel God is punishing me," or "I refuse to forgive this person, even though the Bible commands forgiveness because I am not ready to let go."

When we allow our feelings to dictate our relationship with God, we are not following what His Word already declares about us. For instance, if we don't feel forgiven by God, we might assume that He is still angry with us. Similarly, we might not worship God if we don't feel joy. We might even doubt God's presence, even though we have the Holy Spirit living inside of us. We might think we are doing something wrong if we don't feel God's presence during Bible study.

God calls us to live by faith, not by our feelings. This means that our actions should be guided by God's instructions, not our emotions. We shouldn't accept something just because it feels good; we should accept it because it aligns with Scripture. When we choose to align our actions with God's instructions, we are not only living out our faith but also finding a clear and purposeful direction in our lives.
