In Ephesians 1:7, Paul tells us that through Jesus, we have been redeemed by His blood. The word "redeemed" speaks of being bought back, rescued, or delivered from something that once held us captive. This redemption is more than just a theological concept; it is the foundation of our relationship with God.

To be redeemed means that we were once in bondage, slaves to sin and guilt, and separated from God. However. God, in His love, sent Jesus to pay the ultimate price by giving His life so that we could be free. This redemption is not temporary; it is eternal. Jesus' sacrifice on the cross broke the power of sin over us and made a way for us to be restored to our Heavenly Father.

Not only are we redeemed, but we are also forgiven. God doesn't just set us free and leave us on our own. He cleanses us, removes the stain of sin, and invites us into a new life of grace and purpose. This redemption is a gift, not something we earn. It's "by the riches of God's grace." His grace is not just given; it is abundant and freely lavished upon us, a reason for us to be grateful.

Take time today to reflect that you are no longer bound by sin or shame. The blood of Jesus has redeemed you—walk in the freedom He has given you.

Are there areas of your life where you still feel weighed down by guilt? Remember that God has forgiven you completely. His grace is greater than your past. Accept His forgiveness and let go of any lingering guilt or shame.
